The meeting was called to order for the certification and acceptance of the results at 10:05 p.m. by Board President, Ms. McQuillan and she led in the pledge of allegiance.

Certification of the Results of the School Budget Vote & Election

As the Chairperson of the Election and the District Clerk of the Board of Education of the Freeport Union Free School District, I hereby solemnly swear that I have canvassed the returns of the Inspectors of Election and the results are as follows:

For the School Budget Vote, held May 19, 2009, the total number of votes cast for Proposition # 1, resolving that the School Budget of **\$143,587,930** be adopted and the necessary amount be raised by tax upon the taxable property located in Freeport Union Free School District, Town of Hempstead, Freeport, New York, for the year 2009-2010, was **1,734**;

the total number of **yes** votes cast for **Proposition # 1** was: **1270**;
the total number of **no** votes cast for **Proposition # 1** was: **464**; and

For the Library Budget, the total number of votes cast for Proposition # 2, resolving that the Freeport Memorial Library Budget amount of \$5,546,645 be adopted and the necessary amount be raised by tax upon the taxable property located in Freeport Union Free School District, Town of Hempstead, Freeport, New York, for the year 2009-2010, was: **1,544**;

that the total number of yes votes cast for **Proposition # 2** was: **1120**;
that the total number of no votes cast for **Proposition # 2** was: **424**; and

For the Authorization to Establish a Capital Reserve Fund, the total number of votes cast for Proposition #3, resolving that the District be Authorized to Establish a Capital Reserve Fund known as "Facilities Improvement Program – Freeport Public Schools," was: **1453**;

that the total number of yes votes cast for **Proposition # 3** was: **1042**;
that the total number of no votes cast for **Proposition # 3** was: **411**; and

For the Trustee Election, the total number of votes cast for each candidate for the Office of School Trustee, for a three year term to begin July 1, 2009, and end June 30, 2012, was:

the total number of votes cast for **Debra Mulé** was **1218**;

the total number of votes cast for **other** was **1**;

Acceptance of the Results of the School Budget Vote & Election

On a motion by Ms. Piñeyro the following resolutions were adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Freeport Union Free School District hereby accepts the results of the annual budget vote and trustee election held this date, May 19, 2009, as certified by the Chairperson of Election and the District Clerk; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Proposition #1, **School Budget** has been **approved** by the registered voters of this District; and

THAT Proposition #2, **Freeport Memorial Library Budget** has been **approved** by the registered voters of this District; and

THAT Proposition #3, **Authorization to Establish a Capital Reserve Fund** has been **approved** by the registered voters of this District; and

THAT **Debra Mulé** have been elected as a trustee for a term of three years to begin July 1, 2009 and end June 30, 2012; and

The motion was seconded by Mr. Pomerico and passed unanimously. The vote was: Ellerbe, McQuillan, Mulé, Piñeyro and Pomerico.

At 10:20 p.m. Mr. Ellerbe moved to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Ms. Mulé, and unanimously carried: Ellerbe, McQuillan, Mulé, Piñeyro, and Pomerico.
