



SUMMER SCHOOL 2009

GENERAL INFORMATION

Freeport will once again be offering a wide range of summer courses for students in grades 7-12 who have failed one or more courses or Regents exams during the regular school year.

Freeport will be separating the Secondary Summer School. ***Middle Summer School, for students in 7th & 8th grade, will be held at Dodd Middle School and Summer High School, for students in grades 9th - 12th, will be held at the High School.***

REGISTRATION:

If it has been determined that you are eligible to attend Summer School, and we offer the subject(s) you have failed you are automatically registered. Board of Education attendance policy states no one can attend summer school if unexcused absences exceeds 10 days in semester and 20 days in full year courses. A schedule ***will not*** be sent home due to a late end of the school year. Students who wish to take a course for the first time (acceleration) must speak to their guidance counselor **immediately**. Students living in Freeport, but not attending Freeport Public Schools may register for courses. Those students must contact Central Registry (867-5254) and register with the FHS Guidance Department **prior to Monday, June 30th**.

ATTENDANCE POLICY:

Attendance for the required days is the responsibility of the student and his or her parent(s). Any missed class work and tests will result in a zero grade regardless of absences. **Any student with more than 3 unexcused absences will automatically be dropped from the course!** Parents will be notified if their child has poor attendance and is in danger of failing. Failure of the school to notify parents of impending dismissal is not a basis of reinstatement. Any tardiness that exceeds 15 minutes will be counted as a full period absence and the student will not be allowed to enter that class period.

DISCIPLINE:

The Freeport Public Schools' Code of Conduct shall be enforced in the same manner as during the regular school year. Any student referred to the office for disciplinary reasons may be dismissed for conduct that interferes with the learning atmosphere and will jeopardize his/her chances of successfully completing the summer requirements.

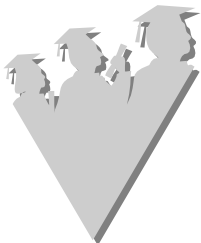
