
SUMMER SCIENCE RESEARCH FOR HIGH SCHOOL SCIENCE RESEARCH STUDENTS

 - Study of Umbra and Penumbra Shadows
 - Launching of an High-Altitude Balloon and determining its trajectory
- Understanding the results of NASA's DART Mission and simulation of a collision between a spacecraft and an asteroid
- Attitude Control in CubeSats
- Determining the presence of heavy metals in clams that are found in Long Island beeches
 - Nanomaterials synthesis and a trip to Brookhaven Laboratory
